

Checkpoint Hävvi i Glen



In recognition of the highly appreciated control station in Arådalen, the race committee has decided to place a formal checkpoint in the nearby area, Hävvi i Glen. In partnership with Elaine and Thomas who own and operate Hävvi i Glen, the Amundsen race provides opportunities to food, lodging, hay and water for dogs, as well as internet connection. The checkpoint Hävvi i Glen is mandatory for the Two-driver sled teams and optional for all others.

FOOD: Soup, sandwiches, coffee and tea will be available day and night for Amundsen participants for a set price. Additional food and meals are available to order, if placed ahead of the race day. If you are interested in a special meal, we recommend that you contact Elaine directly prior to race day.

Housing: Self-service cabins are available, with shower and toilet in a separate building. A wood-based sauna is also available on the premises. Cost for the cabins range between 400-800 sek depending on the size.

Parking: parking for trucks and vehicles associated with the dogs sled team will be available in the area around the conference center.

INTERNET and Mobiltelefon: Net 1 wireless connection is available at the conference center. For those coming from outside of Sweden, we recommend that you check to make sure the telephone operator selected is available in the area due to limited reception.
